13 years since JFK

DALLAS — A hastily organized prayer vigil will mark the anniversary tomorrow of the 1963 assassination of President Kennedy in Dallas. Mayor Robert Folsom had canceled the traditional commemoration, but Dallas County Democratic chairman Ron Kessler said yesterday he received about 500 phone calls protesting the lack of a memorial service. The observance will be held at noon at the Kennedy Memorial, not far from the assassination site. The services will consist of a short prayer and a moment of silence. "There will be no speeches," Kessler said.
