Kennedy Assails Angola-Type Fund 'Frittering'

Snowbird, Utah

Senator Edward Kennedy (Dem-Mass.), visiting Utah on a ski vacation, says Americans don't want their money "frittered away" in places such as Angola.

Kennedy chatted with reporters briefly after flying from Sun Valley, Idaho, to Utah Saturday where he, his wife and three children will spend a week skiing.

Kennedy said Senate action cutting off U.S. funds for CIA operations and other military action in Angola was very important.

"The halting of the interference in Angola, which it appeared we were going to fall into, was an important exercise of the congressional prerogative," he said.
