U.S. Won't Accept MPLA

Washington

The United States has no plans to extend diplomatic recognition to the Communist-backed MPLA organization in Angola as long as Cubans are in that country, presidential press secretary Ron Nessen said yesterday.

"The President has strong personal views about extending diplomatic recognition as long as 12,000 Cuban troops remain in Angola," Nessen said.
