

Kunstler Calls It 'Murder'

MINNEAPOLIS — (AP) — William Kunstler, attorney who acted as a negotiator in the uprising at the state prison at Attica, has called New York Gov. Nelson Rockefeller "an out and out murderer."

Kunstler was quoted by the

St. Paul Pioneer-Press as having made the comment yesterday in a news conference at the Minneapolis-St. Paul Airport. He was en route from Buffalo, N.Y., to conduct a student forum last night at Stout State University, Menomonie, Wis.

"I usually don't use lan-

guage this strong," said Kunstler.

"But there are no two ways about it. Rockefeller is a murderer."

Kunstler told reporters he is convinced continued negotiations would have brought a peaceful conclusion to the prisoners' uprising.
