

3 Leaders of Revolt Reported Still Alive

Three of the men described as leaders of the Attica revolt were reported yesterday to be alive and still in the prison.

They were identified by observers of the riot as Richard Clark, Herbert X. Blyden and Herbert H. Crowley.

Correction officials said they were not among those killed or among the 200 inmates transferred from Attica to other prisons to ease overcrowding. The officials said the three were believed to be in segregated areas of the prison.
