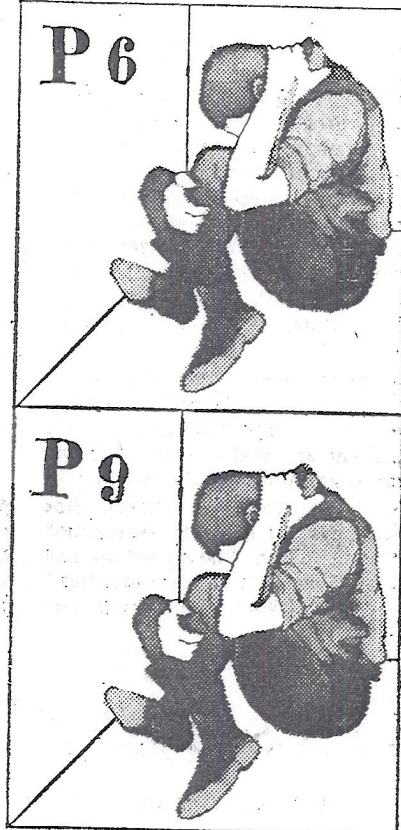


Attica—View From Inside
