USF Rally for Harrisburg Six

More than 1000 persons attended a fund-raising rally here yesterday in support of six persons — including Father Philip Berrigan — accused of plotting to kidnap presidential advisor Henry Kissinger and conspiring to blow up the heating systems of several government buildings.

No figures were immediately available but patrons were charged 50 cents admission at the door of the University of San Francisco gymnasium.

Featured speakers included Sister Elizabeth McAllister — one of the co-defendants known as the "Harrisburg Six" — and actress Jane Fonda, who also met briefly with Angela Davis yesterday at the Marin County Jail.

Sister Elizabeth McAllister professed the innocence of

the Harrisburg Six, saying, "Unlike our government, we have never lied about our actions."

She told newsmen that it is the U.S. government which is involved in abduction and violence — the abduction of thousands of young men into the army monthly and the violence of war in Southeast Asia.

The Harrisburg Six, she said, believes in "the holy commandment, 'Thou shalt not kill,' a commandment which our government has violated with impunity a million times."
