

Philip Berrigan Is Returned To Danbury Cell After Fast

SPRINGFIELD, Mo., Sept. 20 (UPI)—The Rev. Philip F. Berrigan and six other prisoners, pronounced fit after their month-long fast to protest the prison parole system, were returned to Danbury, Conn., Federal prison today to serve out their sentences.

Dr. P. J. Ciccone, director of the United States Medical Center for Federal Prisoners, said Father Berrigan and the others were returned to Danbury aboard a chartered plane.

Father Berrigan is serving a sentence for destroying draft records in 1968 at Catonsville, Md. He is also a defendant in the Harrisburg, Pa., conspiracy case involving an alleged plot to blow up heating ducts in Washington buildings.
