

Phillip Berrigan Seized in 'Cell' Near White House

Washington

Anti-war activist Phillip Berrigan was arrested on the street outside the White House yesterday as he sat shackled in a simulated "tiger cage" prison cell.

The tiger cage, a 8-by-8-by-4 foot structure used in South Vietnam, was

mounted on a flatbed truck and was on display outside the executive mansion.

Two men, Hank Clement Skrypeck of Baltimore and William Michael Murphy of Washington were arrested with Berrigan. Skrypeck was in the cage with Berrigan, and Murphy was driving the truck.

All three were charged with parading without a permit and were released on \$750 bond each.

Berrigan said later the arrest was probably illegal, but a spokesman for the U.S. Park Police said a permit for the display was required.
