

The Mail-Snooping by CIA and Post Office Told

A top postal official [William J. Cotter, chief inspector, Postal Service] and a former CIA agent [Mel Crain, San Diego State University professor who left the CIA in 1959] revealed yesterday how the agencies teamed up for over 20 years to open illegally and read the mail of Americans corresponding with persons in Communist countries.
