The FBI has sent a photo analyst to Dallas, Tex., as part of the Rockefeller Commission's investigation of charges that the CIA was involved in the assassination of President Kennedy, sources say.

The sources said the com-mission asked the help of the FBI to check out a claim

by activist Dick Gregory that a newspaper photo proves Watergate burglars E. Howard Hunt and Frank Sturgis were at the 1963 assassination.

An FBI spokesman in Dallas confirmed that the photo expert was there but not on orders from the commission. He confirmed that the com-mission has made "some inquiries about some old photographs "

The picture shows three shabby men who were arrested for vagrancy soon after the assassination. Gregory and associates say two of the men resemble Hunt and Sturgis, both for-mer CIA agents.

Hunt and Sturgis reportedly have denied being in Dal-Tas the day of the slaying.
