The Army has reassigned Dr. Van H. Sim, head of the research program at Edgewood Arsenal in Maryland in which the hallucinogenic drug LSD was given to 585 servicemen. Attributing the action to "allegations made in the media," a spokesman said that the Army had made no charges against Dr. Sim. Currently on leave, he will return as special adviser to the arsenal's technical director and will have no personal involvement with testing programs.
