

Inventor's Regrets About LSD

Dr. Albert Hoffman, who developed the drug LSD in the 1930s, says he thinks the drug has medical value but expressed regret that it has been abused.

Hoffman, lecturing at Purdue University, told a news conference LSD still has medical uses, but efforts to halt illegal use of thz drug should be continued.

When he created LSD, Hoffman wws looking for a cure for epilepsy. He said the drug wasn't the answer to this disease, but since has been used in treatment of some mental patients.
