Oswald's Plans Known To CIA

The [CIA] knew [Oswald] was plotting to assassinate [Kennedy] almost two months before the assassination, the News American has been informed.

But the information, gathered by CIA agents in Mexico City, got pigeonholed in a bureaucratic maze until it was too late to effectively protect the life of Kennedy.

"The director didn't get the information until the morning of the assassination," said a source who was close to CIA operations at that time....

CIA agents in Mexico City kept constant surveillance on Oswald during his visit there in late September 1963. They bugged his conversations inside the Cuban and Soviet embassies and reportedly had an undercover man in a session in which Oswald and others discussed plans for the assassination.

The clandestine meeting was attended by Oswald, at least one Communist party member from Texas and a woman, among others....
