House Delay On Kissinger

Washington

The House intelligence committee voted 8 to 5 yesterday to postpone taking any action on Secretary of State Henry Kissinger's refusal to turn over a subpoenaed memorandum said to be critical of U.S. actions during the 1974 Cyprus crisis.

The committee voted to wait until November 3, after Kissinger appears before the panel to testify about the memorandum and other criticism and advice he received during the Cyprus crisis. Kissinger is scheduled to testify October 23 and 31.
