

## Mafia Use of Woman With JFK Doubted

Washington

There is no evidence the Mafia tried to exploit President John F. Kennedy's relationship with a California woman who had links to organized crime, according to Chairman Frank Church of the Senate intelligence committee.

"There is no evidence to suggest she was a conduit of any kind," Church said yesterday in response to questions about the relationship between Judith Campbell and the late President.

The committee uncovered the

relationship, which included 70 phone calls between the White House and Miss Campbell, in the course of investigating whether Kennedy knew of CIA plots to assassinate Cuban Premier Fidel Castro.

Miss Campbell, now reported to be living in California under a different name, was interviewed extensively by the staff, Church said, but the relationship was outlined only briefly in the report because, "We did not think it appropriate to wade into the personal life of the President."
