A British Paper Names 2 Russians As Secret Agents

London

A British newspaper yesterday named a member of the Soviet embassy in London as a military spy and another as the man responsible for looking after the interests of the Soviet secret police in the British capital.

The newspaper, the Sunday Express, also published the addresses of the two men in London.

The Sunday Express normally backs Britain's opposition Conservative party. The report appeared in the newspaper's "Town Talk" gossip column.
