(On "agreement" between House Select Committee on Intelligence and the White House:)

Lisagor: Chairman Pike has now said there was never a written agreement. The White House agrees that there was never a written agreement on this. Pike [says] that there was never an agreement affecting the report. The White House is a little ambivalent about that; they say that maybe that is true, but the confidential documents in the report were proscribed. So I think that we ought to establish those facts because everybody has accepted that an agreement in which - you know, that there's an agreement in blood. There apparently was no such thing.
