## A Scream of Hate Against Americans

"The Americans are worse than the Viet Cong!" the tiny woman screamed hysterically. "I'm going to join the Viet Cong — I'm going to blow up the Americans!"

Cham Kimlienr, the wife of the double agent allegedly slain in the Green Beret murder case, held an infant in her arms and her voice rose frantically. She had just been told the charges against the eight Green Berets accused of the killing had been dropped.

"The Americans are cruel—they say they are the leaders of the free world—but they don't believe in freedom or democracy or justice at all," she said.

She insisted her husband, Thai Khac Chuyen, was never a double agent and had worked faithfully for the Americans. Vietnamese women retain their maiden names after marriage.

"I'll kill myself—I'll kill myself and my children," she said, trying to swallow her sobs. She stood outside her small home on a dirt road not far from downtown Saigon. Neighbors gathered around her gate and her mother, who had been standing in the doorway, ran to her.
