Chile Lets Nephew of Allende Go

Santiago, Chile

Andres Pascal Allende, nephew of Chile's late president, flew out of the country last night en route to Costa Rica and political exile.

With him was his companion, Mary Ann Beausire, 24.

Allende, 32-year-old leader of the outlawed Revolutionary Left Movement, and Miss Beausire had sought asylum in the Costa Rican embassy November 7 after a gun fight with security agents the previous month.

Chile's military government initially refused to grant them safe conduct passes to leave the country, saying they were common criminals. It relented under pressure from Costa Rica and other Latin American countries and issued the passes January 21.
