House Panel Vote Bars Military Aid to Chileans

WASHINGTON, Feb. 4 (Reuters)—A Congressional committee today voted to bar military aid to Chile until President Ford and Congress determined that the Chilean Government had made progress on respecting human rights.

The ban was attached as an amendment to a foreign military aid bill by the House International Relations Committee.

The committee rejected a tougher version of the amendment proposed by Michael Harrington, Democrat of Massachusetts, that would have cut off a \$33-million World Bank loan to Chile. The Harrington amendment was strongly opposed by Administration spokesmen.
