

**Stennis Continues to Make
A 'Satisfactory' Recovery**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 11 (AP) — Senator John C. Stennis, Democrat of Mississippi, continued today to make satisfactory progress in recovering from gunshot wounds, a spokesman for Walter Reed Medical Center reported.

Senator Stennis, 71 years old, chairman of the Senate Armed

Services Committee, was wounded in a holdup outside his home Jan. 30.

The hospital said: "The Senator's satisfactory progress continues. He spent a restful night, is awake and in excellent spirits. The Senator is spending a comfortable day.

"He sat up in his chair again today. His vital signs are good. His condition continues to be listed as very serious; prognosis continues guarded."
