More Surgery For Stennis

Senator John C. Stennis, seriously wounded in a hold-up near his home January 30, had additional surgery yesterday for repair of his abdominal wounds and for removal of a bullet.

Stennis "tolerated the surgery satisfactorily," a spokesman for Walter Reed Army Medical Center said, and is expected to recover from the surgery in four to six weeks.
