

Pardon From President

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19 (AP) — President Ford has granted a full and unconditional pardon to a Las Vegas, Nev., odds-maker known as Jimmy the Greek Snyder for a conviction 11 years ago on gambling violations.

The pardon took effect Wednesday and was made public by the Justice Department Thursday.

Mr. Snyder, whose real name is James G. Synodinos, was sentenced to five years probation and fined \$10,000 after being convicted for interstate transportation of bets and wagering information, conspiracy and violation of the Federal Communications Act.

It was one of 147 pardons Mr. Ford issued Wednesday in continuing the Presidential custom of Christmas-season pardons.
