Sky Is Limit for Rocky's Campaign

There is no limit on the amount Vice President Nelson Rockefeller or anyone else running for his job can spend in seeking nomination for the post.

Federal officials frankly described the situation yesterday as a "loophole" in the new federal election law.

President Ford and his potential Democratic opponents are limited to \$10 million in the amount they can spend to get the nomination, but there is no limit on the vice presidential candidate.

Rockefeller spokesmen were quick to say the vice president, one of the world's richest men, isn't going to take advantage of the situation. Press spokesman John Mulliken said Rockefeller doesn't plan to spend any money on personal political activities before next summer's Republican convention.
