# Jack Ford's Lively Days And Nights

President Ford's 23-year-old son Jack, who caused a sensation a few days ago when he said he has smoked pot, does not find White House life too restricting and is discovering social advantages in being the handsome, unmarried and willing son of a U.S. leader, *People* magazine reports.

"A little work and a lot of play have made Jack anything but a dull boy," the magazine says, adding that there is talk in Washington that he may even have lit up a joint or two in the White House.

The magazine says that being accompanied by Secret Service agents could crimp a social life — but Jack Ford had managed.

"On his travels to the Helsinki summit this summer, he teamed up with his pal David Hume Kennerly, the swinging White House photographer, for some long evenings in the land of the midnight sun. 'We don't think he's a virgin,' a White House source revealed, 'in fact we rather hope he's not.'"

People also says there are reports Kennerly was admonished by the President "for demonstrating to young Jack that the primrose path was a lot more fun than the yellow brick road."
