Humphrey Tops Ford in Harris Poll

New York

A survey of 1214 voters on their choice for President next year shows 52 per cent prefer Senator Hubert Humphrey over President Ford, the Harris Poll reported yesterday. Forty-one per cent said they would vote for Mr. Ford.

Those polled also preferred Humphrey over Ronald Reagan, 50 to 43 per cent, the survey showed.

In a similar Harris Poll last April Mr. Ford had a 47-to-46 per cent lead over Humphrey. By September, that figure had grown to a 48-to-42 per cent lead.
