

**Quiiroga, Carlos**

Associated with Sergio Arcacha Smith in Cuban liberation movement in 1963 in New Orleans, according to Merriman Smith. May be in New Orleans or somewhere in Texas. *LA Herald-Examiner*, 3/5/67

Subpoenaed for New Orleans grand jury. Garrison described him as a close associate of Sergio Arcacha Smith who charged with Novel in Houma burglary 1961.

Quiiroga denied to newsmen. 5/9/67

Garrison's contention that Oswald was not a communist but a CIA agent who worked with anti-Castro groups. *AP* 5/10/67 143pcd et al

Subpoenaed to appear before grand jury. *AP* 24may67 B50 835acd

Ibid: described as close friend of Arcacha Smith who founded the *Cuban Democratic Revolutionary Council*, which closed New Orleans office early in 1962.

Subpoenaed to grand jury for 5/10/67. Described as 30, address 3134 Derby Place. *New Orleans States-Item*, 5/9/67 Subpoenaed for Grand Jury again. *New Orleans States Item*, 5/23/67

Reporting Quiiroga's second summons, *UPI* says grand jury moving to attic of the criminal courts building. Says Garrison aides say because of noise in existing quarters. *San Francisco Examiner UPI*, 5/24/67

Quiiroga, 30, testified yesterday .... refused comment ... but previously he said he has no knowledge of any plot to kill President Kennedy. *San Francisco Examiner AP*, 5/25/67

Testified for two hours 5/24/67, emerged without comment. *New Orleans States Item*, 5/25/67

Garrison says Quiiroga told him 14-man group he say: assassinated JFK was trained in St. Tammany Parish the summer of 1963, with Ricardo Davis acting as liaison man with unidentified Americans who financing the training.

Says training under famous Cuban underground member identified only as "Peneque." Garrison says Ferrie also helped train or was connected Arcacha Smith, Jim Squires, *Nashville Tennessean*, 6/22/67
