NEW ORLEANS, FEB. 20-(AP)-A MAN WHO SAYS HE WAS AN INVESTIGATOR WHEN LEE HARVEY OSWALD LIVED HERE SAYS FOUR OR FIVE PERSONS WERE INVOLVED IN A PLOT TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND "SOME OF THEM ARE STILL IN NEW ORLEANS."

DAVE LEWIS, WHO NOW WORKS AT A BUS STATION, REPORTEDLY IS ONE OF DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S WITNESSES. GARRISON HAS SAID HIS CURRENT INVESTIGATION WILL SHOW THAT THERE WAS AN ASSASSINATION PLAN AND THAT IT ORIGINATED HERE.

IN AN INTERVIEW, LEWIS SAID HE COULD ONLY SAY THAT FOUR OR FIVE PERSONS WERE INVOLVED. HE SAID HE HAD BEEN TOLD TO KEEP HIS MOUTH SHUT. ✓

"I WON'T NAME ANY NAMES UNTIL GARRISON TELLS ME SO," LEWIS SAID. "THERE DEFINITELY, ABSOLUTELY WAS A PLOT. THERE WAS OTHER PEOPLE INVOLVED BESIDES OSWALD."

OSWALD, WHO PASSED OUT PRO-CASTRO PAMPHLETS HERE DURING THE SUMMER OF 1963, HAS BEEN NAMED AS THE ASSASSIN BY THE WARREN COMMISSION. THE COMMISSION SAID IT FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF AN ASSASSINATION PLOT.

ASKED WHY HE HADN'T TURNED HIS INFORMATION OVER TO THE FBI EARLIER, HE SAID "THE FBI DIDN'T ASK ME ABOUT IT."

LEWIS IS EMPLOYED AT THE TRAILWAYS BUS STATION HERE AS A BAGGAGE EXPRESSMAN. HIS DUTIES ARE TO SEE THAT BAGGAGE IS PLACED ABOARD DEPARTING BUSES.
