GARRISON, WHO SAYS HE'LL PROVE A CONSPIRACY WAS HATCHED IN NEW ORLEANS WHICH CULMINATED IN THE ASSASSINATION IN DALLAS OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, REMAINED SECLUDED.

FERRIE, 48, WAS FOUND DEAD IN HIS APARTMENT LAST WEDNESDAY.

HEMORRHAGE. GARRISON INSISTED IT WAS SUICIDE.

SOMETIME PILOT, SOMETIME PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR, FERRIE INSISTED IN INTERVIEWS BEFORE HIS DEATH HE HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT IN DALLAS NOV. 22, 1963. HE SAID GARRISON WAS TRYING TO FINGER HIM AS THE "GET-AWAY PILOT" IN AN ALLEGED PLOT.

FERRIE LIVED ALONE. A NATIVE OF CLEVELAND, OHIO, FERRIE HAD MADE NEW ORLEANS HIS HOME FOR THE PAST 15 YEARS.

IN DALLAS, MEANWHILE, SERGIO ARCACHA, A PRO-CASTRO CUBAN DIPLOMAT, SAID HE KNEW NOTHING ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION OR OF THE INVESTIGATION BEING CONDUCTED BY GARRISON.

ARCACHA, 44, WORKS IN THE EXPORT DEPARTMENT OF A DALLAS AIRCONDITIONING MANUFACTURING COMPANY. HE TOLD NEWSMEN HE LEFT CUBA 26
DAYS AFTER CASTRO CAME TO POWER AND WAS A DELEGATE FROM THE CUBAN
REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT IN NEW ORLEANS, HELPING TO COORDINATE PLANS
FOR THE BAY OF PIGS INVASION UNTIL 1962.

ARCACHA REFUSED TO SAY WHETHER HE KNEW FERRIE.

NEW ORLEANS POLICE SAY THEIR RECORDS SHOW OFFICERS STOPPED TWO YOUNG MEN IN AN AUTO ON AUG. 30, 1961, AND FOUND A PISTOL AND A MAKEUP KIT WITH A WIG. THE YOUTHS TOOK THEM TO THE HOME OF SERGIO ARCACHA, THE POLICE REPORT CONTINUED, AND ARCACHA'S WIFE SAID THE PISTOL AND KIT BELONGED TO FERRIE, WHO HAD BEEN AT THE HOUSE A SHORT TIME EARLIER.

THE YOUTHS WERE RELEASED.

AUTHORITIES SAY FERRIE HAS RELATIVES IN OTHER CITIES BUT NONE HAVE COME FORWARD TO CLAIM THE BODY FOR BURIAL.
