

'Conspiracy' Witness to Go To New Orleans

Raymond Cummings, a former taxi driver quoted as saying he has information about Lee Harvey Oswald, David Ferrie and Jack Ruby, will go to New Orleans Monday, his lawyer said yesterday.

The lawyer, Frank Wright, said Charles Ward, chief prosecutor for Jim Garrison, New Orleans District Attorney, asked that Cummings come to New Orleans.

Cummings entered the case with a statement that he once drove Oswald and Ferrie to Jack Ruby's night club here.
