New Orleans, March 16 (AP)-Dean Andrews Jr., an attorney who says he cone handled some legal matters for Lee Harvey Oswald, we appeared before the Orleans Parish grand jury today for the second time in connection with the district attorney's probe of the Kennedy assassinatimen.

Meanwhile, Andrews was suspended as an assistant dirstrict attorney in suburban Jefferson Farish.

Andrews appeared by himself before the grand jury today. reviously he had been accompanied by an attorney.

A subpoena was also issued for Gordon Nevel to appear before the grand jury. "ovel, who owns the Jamaican Village, a bar on the fringe of the French archer, quarter, had not previously been linked with the case.

Andrews said Novel, 29, was a friend and client.

In an interview, Novel said Garrison wanted to question him about events during 1961 which involved former Cuban exile leader Sergio Arcacha.

Arcacha lived in ew Tleans during 1961 and headed an anti-Castre group which had headquarters at 544 Camp Street here.

When Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused assassin of President Anneady was arrested here in August 1963 while distributing pro-Castro Fair Play for Suba literature, some of the pahphlets listed the 544 Camp Street address.

The Warren Commission, however, said it could find no connection between "swald and the address.

Garrison's aides have attempted to question Arcacha in Dallas, where he now lifes. Arcacha would not submit to questioning unless Dallas authorities were present and Garrison would not agree to this.

The grand jury also questioned today a young man who told a newsman his name was Tommy Clark. Clark said he had not been subpoensed but had been asked to appear by one of Garrison's assistants.
