NEW YORK, MARCH 25 (AP)-THE HEARST HEADLINE SERVICE AND THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING CO. REPORTED TODAY THAT THEY HAD INTERVIEWED GORDON NORVEL, MISSING WITNESS IN THE NEW ORLEANS INVESTIGATION OF THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION.

BOTH ORGANIZATIONS INTERVIEWED THE 29-YEAR-OLD ELECTRONICS FIRM OWNER IN MCLEAN, VA. THE HEARST SERVICE SAID IT LOCATED NORVEL "IN HIS HIDEAWAY" BY TELEPHONE, AND NBC PAID TRANSPORTATION COSTS.

NO EFFORT WAS MADE TO DETAIN NORVEL, THE HEARST SERVICE SAID, AND NO DETAILS WERE GIVEN OF WHERE HE WAS FOUND. THE TWO NEWS SERVICES SHARED RESULTS OF THE INTERVIEW.

NORVEL WAS SUMMONED BEFORE A GRAND JURY 10 DAYS AGO IN CONNECTION WITH DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S INVESTIGATION OF POSSIBLE CONSPIRACY TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

HE APPEARED, DID NOT TESTIFY, AND THEN LEFT NEW ORLEANS.

WHEN CALLED AGAIN, HE COULD NOT BE FOUND. NEW ORLEANS OFFICIALS

SEEKING NORVEL AS A MATERIAL WITNESS, ASKED POLICE IN CHICAGO TO

HELP LOCATE HIM.
