Arrestment Set for Key 'Plot' Figure

Clay L. Shaw, central figure in District Attorney Jim Garrison's assassination investigation, will be arraigned next Wednesday on a charge that he conspired to murder President Kennedy.

The arraignment date was agreed on yesterday by Garrison's office and Shaw's lawyers.

The district attorney has alleged that Shaw, 54, conspired with Lee Harvey Oswald and David W. Ferrie to kill the President. F. Irvin Dymond, one of Shaw's defense attorneys, said his client would enter a plea of not guilty.
