# JFK Assassin Probers Question Julius Oswald

NEW ORLEANS (UPI) — Julius Oswald, one of the four Oswalds whose names have come up in Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's investigation of the Kennedy assassination, was questioned by Garrison's office Thursday.

OSWALD, who worked in the same coffee plant as Lee Har-

vey Oswald, refused to talk to newsmen as he arrived. He slipped out a back door as he left.

The four Oswalds are Julius, William, an uncle of William's with the same name, and Lee Harvey, named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President John F. Kennedy.
