**Any News on Saboteurs?**

More than two months ago, Louisiana was shocked at the dynamiting or attempted dynamiting of six gas wells in five parishes. Two wells were damaged.

The sabotage was unthinkable in a state—the No. 2 gas producer in the nation—which bases so much of its economy on the gas industry and which aggressively sells industrialization on the hospitality of its business climate.

“I am convinced we will bring them (the dynamiters) to justice,” declared Gov. John J. McKeithen, “and they will be sorry.”

Since the depredations were spread across five parishes—Acadia, Jefferson Davis, Vermilion, St. Martin and Cameron—law enforcement officials should have turned up something by now.
