## 'CIA Knows Answers on JFK'

NEW ORLEANS. — (AP) District Attorney Jim Garrison says Lee Harvey Oswald did not kill President Kennedy and the CIA knows who did.

"Purely and simply it's a case of former employes of the CIA, a large number of them Cubans — having a venomous reaction from the 1961 Bay of Pigs episode . . . certain individuals with a fusion of interests in regaining Cuba assassinated the President," Garrison says.

In Washington, a spokesman for the Central Intelligence Agency said the organization has no comment on Garrison's remarks, made last night in a 23-minute TV interview.

Garrison said the CIA knows "the name of every man involved and the name

of the individuals who pulled the triggers" to kill John F. Kennedy.

And he says the CIA has "infinitely more power than the Gestapo and the NKVD of Russia combined."

He referred to police organizations of Nazi Germany and the Soviet Union.

Garrison said it would take only 60 minutes "for the CIA to give the name of every last Cuban involved in this and that's how close we have been to the end for some time, but we are blocked by this glass wall of this totalitarian, powerful agency which is worried about its power."

He repeatedly charged the CIA with blocking his investigation, begun last fall, and "as a result I think that in closing out the case the final

details of evidence that we want will take us much longer, but we're not going to compromise. We're not going to quit. We're going to get them anyway."
