On Garrison investigation, only one question was asked:

- Q. General, last night the District Attorney in New Orleans, Jim Garrison, appeared on television and he again called the Warren Report, in his words, "a fairy tale." Now, have you uncovered any evidence whatsoever to indicate that Garrison may be on the trail of something new or important regarding the assassination, sir?
- A. We have no evidence to that extent whatsoever. I listened to Mr. Garrison on television last night. I heard no evidence. We remain convinced that Oswald and Oswald alone assassinated President Kennedy.
