DA Asks 'Bare-Bosom Club' Be Closed 1 Year

The district attorney's office asked the Civil District Court today to padlock for a year a N. Rampart st, lounge where the bare-bosomed waitresses were arrested last night.

Judge S. Sanford Lavy was asked to order that the club, the Jamaican Village be "not used for any purpose" during

the year. In addition, the DA's office asks that the defendants be enjoined from operating under similar conditions "anywhere in the state."

These requests will be heard by Judge Levy Aug. 11, at which time the defendants are ordered to show cause why a permanent injunction should not be issued.

Booked with obscenity last night were Holanda Calzaba, 19, and Charlotte French, 25, both of whom measure 34-23-36. They were arrested at the club, 800 N. Rampart.

Judge Levy today issued a temporary injunction prohibiting the waitresses from again appearing in the costumes they wore last night.

Vice squadsmen said they had informed the two waitresses they could avoid obscenity if they continued wearing "pasties."

A bartender, Paul Becnel, was booked with allowing obscenity in an alcoholic beverage outlet.
