Haggerty approved a state motion calling for a meeting of attorneys representing both sides to fix a date for the trial. Shaw, a wealthy 54-year-old retired businessman, was arrested March I and charged with participating in what Garrison contends that Shaw, former managing director of the airline pilot named David W. Ferrie and others to kill Kennedy. New Orleans Trade Mart, conspired with Oswald, and a one time Shaw denies there was a plot. Oswald, identified by the Warren 22, 1963, was shot and killed by Ruby two days later. Ruby, who died of cancer last January, denied ever knowing Oswald. Ferrie probe became public.
