

## No Arrests<sup>3 NOV 67</sup> Before Shaw Trial Due-DA

District Attorney Jim Garrison says there will be no more arrests in his Kennedy assassination probe until after the conclusion of the Clay L. Shaw conspiracy trial.

Shaw, who was arrested March 1 and charged with participating in a conspiracy to assassinate the late President, is scheduled to come to trial in February.

Garrison made the statement yesterday following a session of the Orleans Parish Grand Jury.

Testifying before the jury yesterday was a man who describes himself as an early foe of Cuban Prime Minister Fidel Castro. William Dalzell would say only that he was called in connection with the background of the Kennedy assassination.

The jury, which earlier heard witnesses in its probe of organized crime in the city, recessed after hearing Dalzell.
