'New Evidence'

In JFK Slaying

NEW ORLEANS (UPI) — Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison says the Federal Government knew within 10 minutes after President Kennedy was killed that there were a number of individuals firing and not just a lone assassin.

Garrison released three pictures yesterday that he said would show that law enforcement agencies had found one of the bullets which killed the President within 10 minutes after the shooting.

One of the pictures showed a man picking up what Garrison said was a .45 caliber bullet. Another showed a clock atop the book depository which said 12:40 p.m., or 10 minutes after President Kennedy was shot, according to Garrison.
