ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. (AP)-NEW ORLEANS DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON CHARGES PRESIDENT JOHNSON WITH "CONCEALING EVIDENCE ON THE ASSASSINATION" OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

GARRISON, WHO CONTENDS MORE THAN ONE PERSON WAS INVOLVED IN THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, SAID AS LONG AS PRESIDENT JOHNSON "CONTINUES TO CONCEAL. . . AMERICANS HAVE TO THINK ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY JOHNSON WAS AWARE OF THE ASSASSINATION PLANS BEFORE THE ASSASSINATION."

GARRISON SAID IN THE THURSDAY NIGHT SPEECH HE DOESN'T THINK PRESIDENT JOHNSON PARTICIPATED IN THE SHOOTING. HE ALSO CALLED

PRESIDENT JOHNSON PARTICIPATED IN THE SHOOTING. HE ALSO CALLED FOR JOHNSON TO MAKE AVAILABLE AUTOPSY PICTURES AFTER AFTER THE SHOOTING. HE SCORED THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT, WHICH NAMES LEE HARVEY OSWOLD AS THE LONE ASSASSIN.

THE NEW ORLEANS LAWYER CALLED THE REPORT A "NETWORK OF LIES AND HALF-TRUTHS . . . TO FOOL YOU."

GARRISON SAID HE SEES THE TRUTH IN THAT:

--OSWOLD DID NOT FIRE A GUN THE DAY OF ASSASSINATION.

--RIFLE SHOTS CAME FROM AT LEAST FOUR DIRECTIONS INCLUDING

A SEWER.

--A DALLAS, TEX., POLICEMAN WAS KILLED BY TWO MEN AND AT LEAST 10-15 MEN WERE INVOLVED.
