

Sony 102:

- 75 - Ferrie had access to Douglas two-engine aircraft at Houston International Airport.
- 160 - Heart attack pills. (Transcript filed Necrology.)
- 275 - George Lincoln Rockwell's death being kept in mind as possibly having some connection with assassination; the name of Dan Burroughs, Rockwell's national secretary in American Nazi Party, in Oswald's notebook.
- 360 - Mafia contract to kill Garrison.
- 370 - When subpoena was issued for Edgar Eugene Bradley there was a rumor that a Leslie Bradley was operating at Lakefront Airport, where Ferrie operated. Garrison determined that this Bradley was not identical with Edgar Eugene Bradley. When his investigator returned to airport the following day, was told that FBI had been there and seized all their records. Turner says FBI going around the country picking up any records that might be relevant to Garrison's investigation, giving no receipts.
- 420 - In answer to question about suppression of documents in National Archives, Turner says that in 1963 assassination of a president was not a federal crime and therefore the evidence legally does not belong to the federal government but to the several states. Garrison, as duly constituted law enforcement officer of Louisiana certainly has a legal right to it.
- 460 - Dr. McClelland in memorandum written afternoon of 22 Nov 63 gives cause of death as gunshot wound of left temple; Dr. Johnson (not further identified) was of the same opinion.
