Shaw trial Feb. 13

NEW ORLEANS, La. (LNS)— Judge Edward Haggerty announced that Clay Shaw, accused by D.A. Jim Garrison of conspiring to murder President Kennedy, will stand trial February 13.

Haggerty said that he knows of only one more delaying action that can be taken. This is a change of venue, which would move the trial out of New Orleans because of

prejudicial publicity. He said that if Shaw's attorneys make this motion, he will consider it as the trial proceeds.

Observers take this to imply that he has already decided to reject such a motion. Assuming Shaw and Garrison remain in good health, it looks as if the trial will start as currently scheduled.
