(Continued from Page 1) 21, 1963 - the day before the assassination she was examined by Dr. Victor Weyss

Jr., the hospital's psychiatrist.
In an affidavit, Weyss said that Miss Cherami told him that "the President and other Texas public officials were going to be killed on a visit to Dallas." She mentioned Ruby, Weyss stated.

In the meantime, Texas officials heard that Miss Cherami had been picked up in Louisiana. While she was in Jackson Hospital, she was interviewed by a Houston police officer and promised to expose a narcotics ring in Houston, Tex.

On Nov. 26, the Houston of-ficer and Lt. Fruge of Louisiana, took Rose, by plane, to Houston. While in the plane, she picked up a newspaper which headlined Ruby's killing of Lee

When Miss Cherami read that Ruby claimed to have never known the alleged assassin, she laughed, according to Fruge's

report.
"Why, Jack knew Oswald the lieutenant reported. "They were very good friends. Oswald often visited Jack at the Carousel and I saw them talking to each other often."

In Houston she repeated the story to a Capt. Morgan, of the Houston police.

She later was turned over to the FBI, but no one knows what happened while she was in that organization's custody.

"According to our file," Sciambra related, "all the information she gave on the narcotics ring was true and good. The ring was broken on the basis of her information."

Sciambra said that when Garrison started his investigation, Lt. Fruge was sent to Texas to see if he could locate Miss Cherami.

Fruge spent several days in Texas searching for her. He finally tracked down her sister and discovered that Miss Cherami had been killed in an accident on Sept. 4, 1965

Sciambra said that she had been run down by a car near Gladewater, Tex., at about 2 a.m. He added that because of Texas law, his office has never been able to get a copy of the accident report.
