NEW ORLEANS' DA Jim Garrison is getting 100 per cent co-operation and "vital" assistance from Lee Harvey Oswald's widow, Marina, in his JFK assassination probe. As a subpoena witness she will be immune from prosecution when she gives her hot testimony in open court concerning Oswald's activities and associations in New Orleans during the summer preceding the JFKilling.

Clay Shaw, the New Orleans lawyer, civic leader, already indicted by Garrison, is leading the life of a recluse because, Shaw swears, he fears he's been marked for A Hit (underworld slanguage for assassination) . . . Jackie
