

Oswald Friend Ordered to Appear Here

Mrs. Ruth Paine of Irving, Tex., has been directed to appear next week before the Orleans Parish Grand Jury in its investigation of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Mrs. Paine was a friend of Lee Harvey Oswald and his wife, Marina, during the months preceding the Nov. 22, 1963, assassination.

District Judge John Mead of Dallas yesterday ordered Mrs. Paine to cooperate with the Orleans jury. She had been subpoenaed for April 18.

In the subpoena request, District Attorney Jim Garrison alleged that Mrs. Paine transported Oswald's rifle from New Orleans to Dallas in September 1963.

The Warren Commission investigating the President's death said Oswald used the rifle to kill Kennedy.

Mrs. Paine said last month she had nothing to add to the Garrison probe.
