**China Warns U.S. on
Buildup in Indochina**

Communist China said yesterday it would not allow the United States to "do whatever it pleases in Indochina."

The statement, issued by the Chinese foreign ministry, declared, "It is our duty . . . to . . . support the three peoples of Indochina till complete victory in the war against U.S. aggression."

There was no suggestion in the Chinese statement that

Peking was contemplating direct intervention.

A commentary published in Peking's Jenmin Jihpao said the insurgents in Indochina were capable of defeating the U.S. on their own.

The foreign ministry statement said that in the last few days American and South Vietnamese troops have been concentrating in large numbers along the Vietnam-Laos border.
