The Soviet Union announced yesterday that it will "urgently" send food and medicine to the people in areas of South Vietnam that have come under Communist control.

The announcement, which was circulated by the official press agency, Tass, did not specify the amount of the aid or the precise destination in South Vietnam but said that the humanitarian aid would go "to South Vietnamese patriots," the Soviet Press term for the Viet Cong.
